SPEEDWAY TRICK sprinted clear at once, raced off the rail while setting the pace, turned back the tandem bids of DOUBLE BLUFF and WON LUCKY MOMENT nearing the quarter and drew off through the lane. COMMUTER was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn, angled inside nearing the three-sixteenths pole and finished with good courage. DOUBLE BLUFF chased the winner from the outside, moved up to engage that rival nearing the quarter and gave way in the drive. KRAIN CORNER was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, raced far wide through the turn and finished with some late run. CANTERBURY ROAD was never far back, raced far wide through the turn and gradually gave way. WON LUCKY MOMENT chased the winner from the inside, moved up to offer a bid nearing the quarter and weakened soon after. SONAR EXPRESS showed no early speed, raced off the rail throughout and was not a factor.
