MAKORS FINALE was away alertly to set a pressured pace from the inside, turned back the bid of D'HONORABALE ONE nearing the quarter and held off the closing WINNING MACHINE to gamely prevail. WINNING MACHINE was bumped at the start, raced just off the leaders, checked nearing the seven-sixteenths pole, lacked racing room into the lane until past the eighth pole, split rivals through the final yards, bumped with D'HONORABLE ONE and finished with good late energy. HOIST was bumped at the start, chased the leaders from the inside, checked nearing the three-eighths marker, stayed on through the drive and gave way grudgingly late. EDGE FORWARD steadied at the break then was allowed to settle, raced far wide through the turn and finished with a steady rally. D'HONORABLE ONE pressed the pace of the winner from the outside, moved up to engage that rival nearing the five-sixteenths pole, gave way slightly in the drive while bumping with WINNING MACHINE and continued to give way. KOOKY SALUKI raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the turn, lacked racing room in mid-stretch and finished well when clear. ASSESSMENT was away alertly to chase the leaders from the outside and weakened after going a half. DRIFT KING showed no early speed, raced far wide through the turn, angled out further into the lane and did not reach contention.
