GO WITH GUSTO was unhurried early, raced far wide through the turn, responded to steady urging and was up in the final strides. OLYMPIC LIGHTS raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the turn, moved up to take a slight edge into the lane but could not resist the winner late. DARE ME DEVIL was bumped at the start, raced off the leaders, moved outside through the turn and finished with good energy. IMMIGRATION chased the leaders from the inside, angled out in mid-stretch and finished willingly. BIJOU BARRISTER lacked early speed, saved ground through the turn, appeared to shy from dirt into the lane and finished well when clear. HOWMUCHISIT was bumped at the start, pressed the pace from the outside, moved up to offer a bid nearing the three-sixteenths pole and gave way in the drive. HE'S A GOBLIN was away alertly to set a pressured pace from the inside and gave way through the final furlong. WARRIOR JON raced off the pacesetters from between foes and gradually weakened.
