TANNERSMILLIONAIRE was bumped at the start, stalked the leaders from the inside, moved up to take command into the lane, opened a clear margin and held off the closing bid of DEE DEE K to prevail. DEE DEE K was bumped at the start, raced just off the leaders, moved outside through the turn and was gaining late. CASCADIAN'S STOREY showed no early speed, lacked racing room nearing the quarter, stayed inside into the lane and finished with good energy. WHOS CALLING NOW raced off the pacesetters from the inside and lacked the needed closing response. CANADIA lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not threaten. LA PEPPER sprinted clear at once, lugged out through the turn and gave way in the drive. ADAYFORPICKNDAISYS raced off the pacesetters early, moved far outside through the turn and gradually gave way.
