Footnotes

KOOKIE GAME was bumped at the start, raced off the leaders from the inside, angled out nearing the quarter, responded when set down for the drive, reached HOT CACTUS nearing the sixteenth pole and drew clear late. HOT CACTUS went to the front at once, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, raced off the rail while setting the pace, stayed clear until deep stretch and gave way to the winner. LITTLEMISSDYNAMITE broke sharply to chase the leaders from the outside and gave way in the drive. BOOBY TRAP lacked early speed, raced far wide through the turn and found her best stride late. BELLATHUMBALINA was void of early foot, raced off the rail throughout and did not threaten. MISLAVERNE chased the leaders from the inside, weakened after going a half, was unsaddled on the back-stretch and vanned off. LIZZIE BROWN was bumped at the start and steadied, chased the leaders from between rivals and weakened after three furlongs. KATY RULES showed no early speed, was pulled up after the opening quarter and walked off.
