CHACHING PETE raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the turn, reached the leaders with a furlong to run, drifted in and held by a narrowing margin. PASSION LIVES HERE steadied at the start, lagged early, saved ground through the turn, angled out in mid-stretch and was gaining on the winner late. YAKUTAT broke sharply to duel for the early advantage from the outside and gave way grudgingly in the drive. RINGO'S GOLD raced off the leaders early, moved up for a striking position in mid-stretch, steadied and finished willingly when clear. BIG DADDY'S VISION lacked early speed, raced far wide through the turn and found his best stride late. SNAPPY COMEBACK lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not menace. MR. PENDLETON chased the leaders from the inside, angled out nearing the quarter, steadied nearing the sixteenth pole and gave way. FIVE BOLD RINGS was away alertly to duel for the lead from the inside and weakened after going a half.
