**Footnotes**

OH MOLLY was allowed to settle, made a strong move in middle of the turn, then angled out in the upper stretch and closed with a rush. PERFECT PEACH took back in hand and was well placed, then moved in the turn, collared leader late but was unable to hold off the winner. PANCHITA showed good early speed, set the pressured pace, then shook loose late and held determinedly. MISTY KNIGHT was away alertly, vied from the outside, then weakened in late stages. SUMMER PROSPECTOR was unhurried early while 4 wide on the turn, then made a mild late rally. TRUMPING was allowed to settle, and was never in contention. ROLLIN BAYOU had no speed, and trailed throughout.
