KID KATABATIC stalked the early pace, moved 3 deep on the turn, loomed boldly entering the stretch, then shook clear under steady urging late. THETRUTHISOUTTHERE was shuffled back at the start and allowed to settle, circled 6 wide through the turn, and was gaining. KITTYS LINK steadily advanced through the turn 4 wide, loomed boldly into the stretch, then hung when pressed. KNIGHT COVER was hustled along from between horses, steadied slightly at the 5/16 pole in traffic, then lacked the needed rally. ASK PETE was rushed to the lead to duel from the inside to the 5/16 pole, faltered off the turn and faded. SANSKRIT stalked the pace inside, then failed to respond when asked. HANDY N BOLD pressed the pace on the outside, dueled through the turn, then weakened and dropped back.
