SPUNKY HARRY raced just off the leaders early, angled outside approaching the stretch, responded to aggressive handling and proved best late. DIAMOND INDY duelled for the lead from between foes throughout and gave way grudgingly to the winner late. COURTING SEATTLE duelled for the lead from the inside throughout and gave way late. BLUFFED YA broke sharply to duel for the lead from the outside and gave way after going a half. FATMANSTEW raced off the leaders from the inside, angled out nearing the three-sixteenths marker and failed to rally. SHINING DAY showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not threaten.
