ITS ALL ABOUT JAKE sprinted clear at once, raced off the rail while setting the pace, increased his advantage into the lane and held off the closing PASSION LIVES HERE to prevail. PASSION LIVES HERE was never far back while racing along the inside, angled slightly into the stretch and was gaining on the winner late. NEWAUKUM CREEK broke sharply to race closest to the winner throughout but failed to gain on that rival in the drive. MAMOONYA chased the leaders from the outside throughout and finished evenly. IT'S OUR PLEASURE showed no early speed, saved ground, checked from pulling up rival nearing the five-sixteenths pole and did not threaten thereafter. GAVINRYAN was void of early foot, raced far wide through the turn and was not a factor. SPEEDY WHEATIE raced off the pacesetters from the outside and gradually weakened. HICKORY ROAD was pulled up nearing the five-sixteenths pole and vanned off.
