WAY TOO MUCH was unhurried early, saved ground into the lane, responded to steady left handed urging and caught GRANDEST SLAM in the final yards. FLAMING BULLET stalked the leaders from the outside, moved steadily through the lane and finished with good energy. GRANDEST SLAM broke in stride to take command at once, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, increased his margin into the lane but could not resist the top two in the drive. PONCHO showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and found his best stride late. EMANCIPATED chased the leaders from off the rail and gave way after going a half. TRITIUM was taken in hand to race off the leaders early, moved up from the outside to offer a bid nearing the quarter and failed to sustain his rally in the drive. SHARPER EAGLE showed brief speed from between foes and weakened.
