Footnotes

LITTLE TOWN FLIRT was bumped at the start, raced unhurried early, angled outside nearing the quarter and again with a furlong to run and was up in the closing yards. HERWAYALLTHEWAY was bumped at the start, dueled for the lead from the outside, gained a brief lead inside the sixteenth pole but could not hold the winner off late. MS MOSCOW MATTIE was bumped at the start, dueled for the lead from the inside, checked nearing the eighth pole, stayed on, was unsaddled on the back-stretch and walked off. CASCADIAN ASH was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, saved ground into the lane and finished with some late run. OUT OF HARBOR was bumped at the start, raced just off the leaders from the outside and failed to rally. CALLER MATTY was bumped at the start, chased the leaders from the far outside and gradually gave way. UNION PRIVEE broke sharply to duel for the early advantage from the outside and gave way after going a half.
