MARQUETCHING sprinted clear at once, raced off the rail while setting the pace and drew off through the lane. MUTINY BAY raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the turn and finished with good energy to gain the place. SECRET ELEMENT chased the winner from the inside throughout and gradually gave way. FASTNFOXY broke sharply to chase the leaders from the outside and gave way after going a half. REGAL FEVER lacked early speed, steadied nearing the seven-sixteenths marker and finished with some late run when clear. ARMED SERVICE was void of early foot, raced wide through the turn and was not a factor. TACTICIAN raced off the leaders throughout and gradually weakened. FLYING JACK lacked early speed, appeared to lose action nearing the seven-sixteenths pole nearly unseating his rider and did not threaten thereafter.
