RYANS ARGUMENT sprinted clear at once, saved ground while setting the pace and drew off through the lane as a handy winner. FINANCIAL OFFICER bobbled at the break, recovered quickly to race closest to the winner throughout, was no match for that rival in the drive but clearly second best. TEN SOUTHERNLIGHTS hopped at the break and was bumped, lagged far back early, moved outside through the turn and finished with good late energy. MARENMAG broke sharply to chase the leaders from the outside and weakened after going a half. SUMMER COWBOY lacked early speed, steadied nearing the half mile pole, saved ground through the turn and failed to rally. BIG QUESTION showed brief speed, raced wide through the turn and weakened. DECISIVE FACT stumbled at the break and unseated his rider.
