### Footnotes

QUINNETTE was bumped at the start, lagged early, rider lost whip nearing the five-sixteenths pole, moved inside into the lane, gained a slight edge with a furlong to run and held off the closing MISS TOP NITE to prevail. MISS TOP NITE was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn, angled out further nearing the three-sixteenths pole and was gaining on the winner late. PRETTY DARN GOOD broke sharply to duel for the early advantage from off the rail and gave way through the final furlong. SMART CODE was never far back, angled outside nearing the quarter, reached the leaders nearing the eighth pole and gave way in the drive. A COURTING VENTURE was away alertly to duel for the lead from the outside and also gave way through the final furlong. The rider of MISS TOP NITE lodged an objection against PRETTY DARN GOOD concerning the bumping between the two at the start and after reviewing the films concluded both horses were of equal fault and made no change.
