SEATTLE GAME was away alertly to set a pressured pace, opened a clear margin nearing the quarter and was ridden out to the wire to increase her advantage. CLEMENS BROOK lacked early speed, saved ground through the turn, angled out nearing the three-sixteenths pole and finished with good energy to gain the place. ATTA LORA was off slow, lagged early, raced far wide through the turn and showed good late speed. SASHA B bobbled at the break, pressed the pace from the outside for five furlongs and gave way. CATHERINE Z'S HOPE was void of early foot, raced wide through the turn and finished evenly in the drive. SHE'S ONLY A DREAM broke sharply to chase the leaders from the inside and weakened after going a half. JADIE CAHILL showed brief speed from the outside was eased through the lane and vanned off.
