### Footnotes

BAD AS CAN BE was off a step slow, lagged early, saved ground through the turns, moved up to engage the leaders into the lane, vied with FUELED BY KAFFINE through a prolonged drive and narrowly edged that rival. FUELED BY KAFFINE lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn, angled out further approaching the stretch, reached the fore with a furlong to run and just missed. HOOFPRIINTSINTIME was never far back, raced wide through the second turn, lacked racing room from the three-sixteenths to eighth pole and finished willingly when clear. DOCTOR PAV was away alertly to duel for the early advantage from the inside, was bumped and checked nearing the three-sixteenths pole while retreating and continued to give way thereafter. OH SO MACHO was away alertly to duel for the lead from the outside, bumped with DOCTOR PAV into the lane and gave way in the drive. TURNABLE BAY chased the leaders from the outside and gave way after going five furlongs. STELLAR BLUE lacked early foot, raced wide through the second turn and did not menace. OVER AND UNDER raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the second turn and gradually weakened.
