LITTLE COOKIE was away alertly to duel for the lead from the inside, came in to impeded rival nearing the sixteenth pole and held gamely to the wire. STRATEGIC PATIENCE lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and finished with good energy. SICILY GRACE pressed the pace from the outside throughout and gave way in the drive. CLASSY PRIZE stalked the leaders from the inside, steadied and hit rail while advancing nearing the sixteenth pole and lost all chance. LIV TO DANCE broke sharply to duel for the lead from the outside and gave way through the final furlong. ALI was bumped at the start, chased the leaders from between foes and lacked the needed closing response. CATANITA was bumped at the start, steadied nearing the nine-sixteenths pole, angled out in mid-stretch and did not threaten. The Stewards conducted an inquiry concerning the steadying of CLASSY PRIZE at the sixteenth pole and after reviewing the films concluded that LITTLE COOKIE had come in to impeded that rival and was disqualified and placed fourth.
