CLASSIELYTE went to the front soon after the start, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, increased his margin into the lane and held off the closing EMANCIPATED to prevail. EMANCIPATED was never far back while racing along the inside, angled out into the lane and was gaining on the winner late. WHITNEY BRIDGE lacked early speed, raced far wide through the turn and finished with good energy. SKYRIDER showed no early foot, angled out nearing the quarter and found his best stride late. MESSY MARVIN raced off the leaders from the inside throughout and failed to rally. BURGUNDY ROAD chased the leaders from the outside and weakened after going a half. DESTINYS ROAR broke sharply to chase the leaders from off the rail and gradually weakened. THUNDER THORN showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not reach contention.
