TOP BANKER AL was away alertly to set a pressured pace from the inside, opened a clear lead nearing the seven-sixteenths pole and drew off through the lane. STOLEN RIO was fractious at the gate, off slow, raced far wide through the turn and finished with a steady rally. CUTIE'S SHAMUS raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the turn and finished evenly in the drive. STELLAR BLUE was never far back while racing along the inside and lacked the needed closing response. BUCKLE broke sharply to press the pace from the outside and weakened after going a half.
