POLO BENDER lacked early speed, steadied nearing the nine-sixteenths pole, moved far outside through the turn, reached the leaders with three-sixteenths to run and quickly drew off. AFLEET PETE raced off the leaders early, moved between foes into the lane and finished with good energy. D DEVIL was bumped at the start, raced off the pacesetters, waited for racing room nearing the quarter, checked nearing the sixteenth pole and finished willingly when clear. TONY'S LEGACY was void of early speed, raced far wide through the turn and finished with a belated bid. EIGHTY EIGHT raced off the leaders early, moved far outside through the turn and did not threaten. GRANDEST SLAM chased the leaders from the outside, moved up to offer a bid nearing the quarter and failed to sustain his rally. MIGHTY ALL STAR was bumped at the start, chased the leaders from between foes, offered a bid nearing the quarter and gave way in the drive. HICKORY ROAD was bumped at the start, showed no early speed, raced off the rail into the stretch, steadied late and did not menace. STORMIN FAST chased the leaders from the inside and weakened after the opening quarter. SEA OF FOG pressed the pace from the

outside and weakened in the drive. SPECIAL NEGOTIATOR was away alertly to set a pressured pace from the inside and weakened after going a half.
