Footnotes

NOOSA BEACH was bumped at the start, stalked the leaders from the outside, responded when set down for the drive and wore down the leaders through the final yards. WINNING MACHINE chased the leaders from the inside, moved between foes nearing the sixteenth pole and finished with good courage. PEACEFUL REIGN was off a step slow, rushed up to contend for the early advantage from the inside and gave way through the final sixteenth. KRUGER PARK was away alertly to duel for the lead and gave way grudgingly in the drive. ASSESSMENT was away alertly then dropped off the pacesetters, moved far outside through the turn and finished evenly late. GALLON was bumped at the start, lacked early foot, raced far wide through the turn, checked when ASSESSMENT came out nearing the sixteenth pole and failed to threaten. ROOSTER CITY raced off the leaders from the inside throughout and lacked the needed closing response. WASSERMAN was bumped at the start, lagged early, moved far outside through the turn and did not threaten. YANKEE BRAVO raced off the leaders from between foes and gradually weakened. ELUSIVE SCHEMES raced off the pacesetters from between foes and weakened after going three furlongs.
