TAKE POINT set a pressured pace from the inside, opened a clear margin into the lane and held off the closing BETTER TO BE LUCKY to prevail. BETTER TO BE LUCKY was never far back while racing from between foes, angled out in mid-stretch and finished with good energy late. FEMMINA PESANTE was off a step slow, raced far wide through the turn and finished with some late run. SECHURA chased the leaders from the outside and gradually weakened. MY CAD I was away in good order to press the pace from the outside and weakened in the drive. MERRY SHERRY was off a step slow, saved ground throughout and failed to menace.
