Footnotes

PREMIER DIABLO settled racing in hand along the inside, angled out leaving the turn to launch his bid, split horses and closed with a rush to wear down his rivals in the final strides. FLAMING BULLET vied for the lead racing four wide, edged clear nearing the furlong marker, continued on willingly but was unable to resist the winner. D DEVIL was away a step slow, settled racing in hand, came five wide to make his rally, and was along in time to earn the show. CITY SPRINT pressed the pace racing two wide from between horses, but weakened during the drive and gave way. AARONS LAST DANCE set the pressured pace racing along the inside, but flattened out entering the stretch and faded. BANKERS YEAR was unhurried early racing along the inside, angled out entering the stretch, and passed his tiring rivals. KATE'S HOPE broke slowly and never recovered. INTENSIVE prompted the pace racing between horses, but came up empty leaving the turn and dropped out. TABLE LINE pressed the pace racing three wide from between horses, but was through after a half and faded fast.
