LAFAYETTE STAR was away alertly to race just off the leaders from the outside, angled out further approaching the stretch, reached the fore with a furlong to run, opened a clear margin and held off the closing TEACHER'S RULE to prevail. TEACHER'S RULE showed no early speed, raced off the rail into the stretch, angled out nearing the eighth pole and was gaining late. DUCOTI broke slow and awkward, moved up quickly to stalk the leaders from the inside, could not stay with the closers late but finished with good energy. ONEPARTICULRHARBOR set a pressured pace from the outside, bumped with SKIMMING THE WAVE in mid-stretch while retreating and continued to give way. SKIMMING THE WAVE broke sharply to press the pace from off the rail, bumped with ONEPARTICULRHARBOR nearing the eighth pole and also retreated.
