ALEX raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside approaching the turn, responded to steady urging and wore down CONFIDENT DIVA in the final sixteenth to win going away. CONFIDENT DIVA stalked the leaders from the inside, angled out nearing the three-sixteenths pole while taking command, drifted out slightly in mid-stretch and could not hold the winner off late. SPARKLING TAPESTRY was never far back while racing from between foes and finished evenly. PEPE LE FEU showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and failed to threaten. BLACKBERRY HILL broke sharply to open a clear lead before going a quarter and weakened after a half.
