HOIST sprinted clear soon after the start, saved ground while setting the pace, increased his margin into the lane and was all out to hold the closers safe late. STRYKER PHD showed no early speed, angled out nearing the quarter and finished full of run to be gaining late. WHY NOT BE PERFECT lacked early foot, raced far wide through the turn and finished with good late energy. ASSESSMENT raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the turn, angled out further into the stretch and finished evenly in the drive. KOOKY SALUKI was void of early speed, saved ground into the stretch, moved up for a contending position with a furlong to run but failed to sustain his rally. D'HONORABLE ONE broke sharply to race just off the leaders from the inside, moved up to offer a bid in mid-stretch and gave way in the drive. EDGE FORWARD chased the leaders from the outside and weakened through the final furlong. WINNING MACHINE chased the winner from the outside throughout and weakened in the drive.
