MEL AND AL broke sharply to set a pressured pace, opened a clear margin nearing the three-eighths marker, was engaged by HANKHANKMCCLANK inside the sixteenth pole and gamely prevailed. HANKHANKMCCLANK was never far back while racing along the inside, angled out in mid-stretch, reached the winner nearing the sixteenth marker and just missed. DISCO D raced far wide through the first turn, steadied nearing the thirteen-sixteenths pole, angled out into the lane and finished with good courage. WARREN'S A LEGEND pressed the pace from the outside and gave way after going six furlongs. OUR WOODY was bumped at the start showed no early speed, saved ground into the stretch, drifted out slightly and finished evenly. THIS LAD IS GOLD raced far wide through both turns and failed to threaten. HE'LL ROCKYOU was off a step slow, raced extremely wide through both turns and was not a factor. POINT NO POINT raced extremely wide through the first turn and failed to offer a bid. LUCKY LAFLEUR was bumped at the start, pressed the pace from the outside for six furlongs and weakened.
