WILLYCAN stalked the leaders from off the rail, angled out in mid-stretch and was up in the closing strides. A K RACER was bumped at the start, dueled for the lead from the inside with HIGHDLBURG, gained a clear margin inside the furlong marker but could not resist the winner late. TRITIUM was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, raced far wide through the turn and finished with good energy. HAVIN A GOOD DAY chased the leaders from the outside, moved up to offer a bid nearing the quarter but failed to sustain his rally. HIGHDLBURG was away alertly to duel for the lead from the outside and gave way after going a half. CASTLE ROMEO lagged throughout.
