SABERTOOTH was away alertly to dictate terms, shook clear through the turn, and was ridden to score as the rider pleased in track record time. BEST ON TAP chased SABERTOOTH to no avail, but finished willingly to clearly prove second best. RANDOM MEMO stalked the pace racing along the inside, lacked the needed late response to threaten the top two, then was all out to hold the show. POKER BRAD settled racing in hand, came three wide to make his bid, but went evenly through the drive. MR. MAKAH was unhurried early, angled out to make a belated rally, but failed to seriously threaten. CRIMSON DESIGN was allowed to settle, came four wide into the stretch, but lacked a response when called upon. TURBAN was hustled along racing between horses, but weakened leaving the turn and faded. SPANISH HIGHWAY showed little.
