NOOSA BEACH raced off the pacesetters early, circled from the outside nearing the quarter, opened a clear lead into the lane and held off the closing ASSESSMENT to prevail. ASSESSMENT raced off the leaders from the inside, steadied nearing the quarter, stayed on in the drive and finished with good energy. TEQUILA GOLD raced off the leaders early, angled out into the lane and finished with a solid rally. PEACEFUL REIGN chased the leaders from the inside throughout and gave way in the drive. BOGACHIEL was bumped at the start, set a pressured pace from off the rail and gave way through the final quarter. SARATOGA BOOT hesitated at the start, saved ground into the stretch and finished with some late run. OUR MINESWEEPER was away alertly to press the pace from the outside for a half and gave way. ABSOLUTELY COOL raced off the leaders early, moved far outside to offer a bid nearing the quarter and failed to sustain his rally. WINNING MACHINE was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not reach contention. HE'S ALL HEART raced off the leaders early, moved far outside through the turn and was not a factor.
