Footnotes

ONEKNIGHTLEDO stalked the leaders from the outside, moved up to offer a bid nearing the three-sixteenths marker, opened a lead and was fully extended to hold SNOOTY GAL safe to the wire. SNOOTY GAL broke sharply to press the pace from the outside, moved up to offer a bid nearing quarter, gained a slight edge, relinquished her lead to the winner and stayed on in the drive to be a willingly second. K LEA ROAD was bumped at the start, raced off the pacesetters from the inside and finished with good energy. MILLE MANITO was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, moved between foes nearing the quarter and finished evenly. BUTTON EM UP was void of early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not threaten. DAWNTERRI raced off the leaders from the outside and was not a factor. WATCHER KNOWS was bumped at the start, showed no early speed, angled out in mid-stretch and did not menace. MY THISTLE was bumped at the start, set a pressured pace from the inside and weakened after going a half.
