BUDS A FLYIN went to the front at once, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, raced off the rail into the lane and held sway to the wire. PHINNEY RIDGE was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, saved ground into the lane and finished with good energy. O SEVEN chased the leaders from the outside throughout and lacked the needed closing response. VITAL MOVE lacked early speed, raced far wide through the turn and finished with some late run. SNAPPY COMEBACK was bumped at the start, raced off the leaders from the inside, steadied nearing the half and finished evenly in the drive. WICKED AND WILD chased the leaders from the inside and weakened into the lane. SALEM SLEW was off slow, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention. RINGO'S GOLD chased the leaders from between foes and weakened in the drive. BOISE CREEK lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not threaten.
