SALTY LE MOUSEE was bumped at the start, set a pressured pace from the inside, responded when set down for the drive and held gamely. CAT ON BASE was away alertly to press the pace from the outside, could not get by the winner in the drive but finished with good energy. POWER STRIP was bumped at the start, pressed the pace from the outside throughout and lacked the needed closing response. DRESS CODE broke sharply to press the pace from the outside and failed to gain in the drive. GIANT'S BENCH broke in to bump rival, lacked early speed, saved ground throughout and lacked the needed rally. JIDDAW was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, raced off the rail throughout and did not threaten. READY FOR CHANGE broke slow and awkward, raced wide through the turn and failed to menace. BIG DADDY'S VISION raced off the leaders from the outside and gradually weakened.
