### Footnotes

TOY TOY TOY was away alertly to race off the pacesetters early, angled outside nearing the three-sixteenths pole and wore down BEST VERSE in the final yards. BEST VERSE pressed the pace from the inside, moved up to gain a slight edge nearing the five-sixteenths pole and gave way grudgingly to the winner late. LOUDER lacked early speed, angled outside nearing the quarter, moved between foes in mid-stretch and finished fastest of all. RIO ROMEO broke in, stalked the leaders from the inside, moved up to offer a bid nearing the eighth pole and gave way in the drive. MR. ICHIBAN lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn and finished evenly late. MILITARY DEPUTY showed no early speed, angled out nearing the quarter and lacked the needed late response. TILLMAN'S IMAGE was off slow, raced off the leaders early, moved far outside through the second turn and gave way in the drive. LAST TIME AROUND was never far back, raced wide through the second turn and gave way through the final furlong. MUST BE JOKING set a pressured pace from the outside for six furlongs and weakened.
