Footnotes

WOOD BE FABULOUS raced of the leaders from the inside, angled out into the lane, gained command a furlong out and held off the closing PASSADO to prevail. PASSADO lacked early speed, saved ground into the lane, angled out in mid-stretch and finished full of run. CASTLE PINES pressed the pace from the outside, moved up to engage the leaders nearing the eighth pole and gave way through the final furlong. HUMOROUS GUY was never far back while racing along the inside and finished evenly in the drive. SHAKE THE IRONS was away alertly to press the pace from between foes, checked nearing the eighth pole and finished evenly when clear. ROAD TO TIPPERARY broke sharply to set a pressured pace from off the rail and gave way after five furlongs. APRIL'S RED TIE showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not reach contention.
