HAPPY ONE was away alertly to press the pace of BUB from the outside, opened a clear lead when that rival was pulled up nearing the five-sixteenths pole and held sway to the wire. WALLY BALLOU showed no early speed, raced wide through the second turn and finished with good energy to be up for the place. BANKERS YEAR was never far back while racing from between foes, steadied nearing the five-sixteenths marker and finished evenly in the drive. BIG HERO raced just off the pacesetters from the outside, checked nearing the five-sixteenths pole and lacked the needed closing response when clear. ROCK THE STONE was void of early speed, raced off the rail throughout and did not rally. MILITARY DEPUTY lacked early speed, also steadied nearing the five-sixteenths marker and failed to rally. FREE ON BAIL chased the leaders from the inside, checked nearing the five-sixteenths pole and weakened thereafter. BUB was hustled along to set a pressured pace, was pulled up nearing the quarter and vanned off.
