LADYLEDUE was away in good order to set a pressured pace from the inside, opened a clear lead in mid-stretch and held sway to the wire. SEEKING EMA raced off the leaders early, moved inside into the stretch and finished with good courage to gain the place. GLO BOU LIZA was never far back while racing along the inside, angled out with a furlong to run but failed to gain on the winner late. PRIVATE LESSON raced off the pacesetters early, moved far outside through the turn and finished with late interest. ESPECIALLY CAPABLE pressed the pace from between rivals, checked nearing the eighth pole and did not threaten thereafter. EYES ON THE PRIZE showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and found her best stride late. WHAT R THE ODDS pressed the pace from the outside and gave way after going a half. WHERE I BELONG was void of early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not threaten. POPULAR DATE lacked early foot, raced off the rail into the lane and was not a factor. LINOVISION was away alertly to chase the leaders from the outside and weakened after a half.
