Footnotes

IMMIGRATION was away alertly to press the pace of DEFEND LIBERTY from the inside, moved up to engage that rival nearing the seven-sixteenths pole, opened a clear margin into the lane and was fully extended to hold HILLBILLY CADILLAC safe in the drive. HILLBILLY CADILLAC broke awkwardly then moved up quickly to stalk the leaders from the inside, stayed inside into the lane, reached the winner with a furlong to run but could not get by that rival in the drive. SWISS LIGHTNING lacked early speed, raced far wide through the turn and finished with some late run. ORLANDO XPRESS raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the turn, gained a contending position into the stretch but failed to sustain his rally in the drive. R J'S PROSPECT showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not reach contention. ITSAFINEREDWINE was void of early foot, raced wide through the turn, lacked racing room from the three-sixteenths to the sixteenth pole and finished willingly when clear. DEFEND LIBERTY broke sharply to duel for the lead from the outside and gave way after going a half.
