OBISPO KID dueled between horses into the stretch, battled gamely in the stretch drive, and proved best. BRIAR ROSE dueled for the lead on the rail, raced in tight quarters and checked slightly near the five-sixteenth pole, battled gamely through the stretch, and missed. SUGAR SLEET raced in mid pack early, ranged up nearing the quarter pole, was no match for the top two, but held the show. CHIC CROSSING raced in mid pack, vied into the stretch, and raced evenly. MIDNIGHT LIGHTNING fractious in the gate, was a bit slow into stride, and failed to reach contention. MAUDULAR broke outward, raced near the back of the field, ducked out sharply near the sixteenth pole, and was no factor. WILD BLACKBERRIES away alertly, showed brief speed and stopped. The rider of BRIAR ROSE claimed foul against the rider of OBISPO KID for alleged interference nearing the five-sixteenth pole. Following the review, the Stewards ruled there was insufficient evidence to warrant a disqualification.
