ALWAYS A DIXIE unhurried early, split rivals on the turn, came two-wide into the stretch and finished strongly to be up in the final strides. NEON QUEEN never far back, moved up along the inside on the turn, took the lead entering the stretch, opened a clear advantage and then just failed to last. GREY TOBE FREE dropped back early, came two-wide into the stretch, split rivals during the drive and finished fast. LATTER DAY PAULA came three-wide into the stretch and finished in a mild rally. GROOMS DERBY prompted the pace while racing two-wide, was carried out slightly by SHANDRA SMILES nearing the quarter pole and weakened slightly late. WHATDIDSHEYAY was three-wide on the turn, was carried out slightly nearing the quarter pole to be five-wide entering the stretch and tired late. ROLLETTE was three-wide on the turn, came seven-wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. ELEGANT COLORS showed little. QUEEN OF MY NIGHTS was through early. SHANDRA SMILES saved ground setting the pressured pace, drifted out slightly nearing the quarter pole and gave way when headed. SILKY SECRET was four-wide on the turn, came six-wide into the stretch and failed to menace.
