ZANDER broke sharply to set a pressured pace, opened a clear margin nearing the five-sixteenths pole and held sway to the wire. TRIBAL RYTHUM was off a step slow, raced off the pacesetters early, angled out in mid-stretch and finished with good energy. HIP HOP CITY raced off the leaders early, angled outside approaching the stretch and was up for the show. CIGAR BOX lacked early speed, saved ground throughout and finished evenly in the drive. WON LUCKY MOMENT was away alertly to press the pace from the outside and gave way through the final furlong. DOUBLE BLUFF was never far back, raced far wide through the turn and gradually gave way. FUNNY STUFF was off slow and bumped, raced wide through the turn and did not reach contention. LOOKS LIKE SNOW was bumped at the start, chased the leaders from the outside and weakened after going a half. ENORMAUS J. R. hesitated at the break and lagged throughout.
