MALIBU RUM was away alertly to stalk the pace of UNTILIFINDYOU from the outside, responded to steady urging and wore that foe down in the final yards to prevail. UNTILIFINDYOU bobbed at the break and was bumped, pressed the pace from the outside, moved up to offer a bid nearing the three-eighths pole, opened a clear margin into the lane and just failed to last. CONTREVE lacked early speed, raced far wide through the turn and finished with a solid late rally. OLYMPIC LIGHTS was taken back soon after the start, raced wide through the turn, angled out further in mid-stretch and finished willingly. BUDDY DAVE was never far back while racing from off the rail, reached a contending position in mid-stretch but failed to gain late. SILVER SNEAKERS raced off the pacesetters early, moved far wide through the turn and lacked the needed late response. MUSICAL TRICK was bumped at the start, set a pressured pace from the inside for a half and weakened.
