STOPSHOPPINGDEBBIE was away alertly to duel for the early advantage from the outside, relinquished the lead to her stable-mate nearing the half, came back to re-take command with a furlong to run and steadily drew clear through the final yards. GOIN TO THE WINDOW was off a step slow, rushed to contend, gained a slight edge nearing the three-eighths marker, stayed in control until mid-stretch but could not match strides with the winner late. BLUEBERRY SMOOTHIE raced off the pacesetters from the inside, moved up for a striking position of her stable-mates with a furlong to run but lacked the needed closing response. SUNSET TIME was off a step slow, raced wide through the turn, angled out further approaching the stretch, reached a contending position in mid-stretch but also failed to gain late. LOCKET was void of early speed, saved ground throughout and finished evenly in the drive. INNOCENT LOVE chased the leaders from the outside, was carried out further by SONG OF SEATTLE nearing the three-eighths pole and gave way in the drive. LASTING ROSE raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the turn and gradually weakened. SONG OF SEATTLE pressed the pace from the outside, lugged out nearing the three-eighths pole and was eased thereafter.
