Footnotes

LEROI VICTOR dueled for the early advantage from the inside, opened a clear lead with a furlong to run and was all out to hold off the closing PHINNEY RIDGE. PHINNEY RIDGE raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the turn, responded when set down for the drive and was gaining on the winner late. MEMORIES FOREVER chased the leaders from the inside, checked nearing the half mile pole, angled out into the lane and finished with good courage. GIFT CERTIFICATE was away alertly to duel for the lead from the outside and gave way through the final furlong. NEWAUKUM CREEK broke awkwardly, lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and failed to menace. RINGO'S GOLD dueled for the lead from between rivals and weakened after going a half. I AM THE JAZZMAN was off a step slow, lagged early, moved outside through the turn and did not menace.
