CARRY ON JOHN broke sharply to stalk the leaders from the outside, moved up to take command with a furlong to run and edged away late. WARRIOR JON lacked early speed, saved ground through the turn, angled out nearing the three-sixteenths pole, was bumped by RESCUE PLAN in the final yards and finished with good energy. RESCUE PLAN was never far back while racing along the inside, lacked racing room in mid-stretch, angled outside, bumped with WARRIOR JON and continued on to finish with a late rally. BLEU TARP dueled for the lead from the outside and gave way in the drive. OLYMPIC LIGHTS was bumped at the start, dueled for the lead from the inside and gave way through the final furlong. ONE QUICK BREW hopped at the start and was bumped, raced wide through the turn and did not reach contention. GENTLEMAN LAWYER raced off the pacesetters from the outside and gradually weakened.
