PETE'S GLORY GIRL raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the turn, reached the leaders with a furlong to run and steadily drew clear. MAJOR ROLE was away alertly to race just off the leaders from the inside, could not match strides with the winner late but finished well to gain the place. COLOR ME TUFF was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, raced far wide through the turn and finished with good energy. SKIMMING THE WAVE chased the leaders from the outside, checked nearing the sixteenth pole and finished willingly when clear. BIRDIE GIRL was bumped at the start, pressed the pace from the outside and gave way through the final furlong. SAY WHAT broke sharply to set a pressured pace from the inside and weakened through the final furlong. SHE'S ONLY A DREAM raced off the leaders from the outside throughout and failed to rally. SMILEY MYLIE reared at the start, angled out approaching the stretch but did not reach contention.
