CAHILL CUTIE was bumped at the start, dueled for the early advantage from the outside, gained a slight edge in mid-stretch and gamely held to the wire. TRICKY TARRADIDDLE broke sharply to duel for the lead from between foes and gave way grudgingly to the winner in the drive to just miss. BLACK 'N SILVER dueled for the lead from the inside throughout and also gave way grudgingly through a prolonged drive. KOOKIE GAME was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, raced far wide through the turn, reached a contending position in mid-stretch but failed to gain on the leaders late. FIESTY LASS was void of early foot, raced wide through the turn and finished evenly. CALLER MATTY showed no early speed, raced far wide through the turn and did not reach contention. POLISH GIFT CARD raced off the pacesetters from the outside and gradually gave way. SHESAFASTLILDEVIL showed brief speed from the inside and weakened.
