COUNT DRAC prompted the pace racing between horses, forged command entering the stretch, and drew clear under steady urging. POVERTY BAY stalked the pace racing three deep, came four wide to make his bid, and was just up to earn the place. KAT'S WARRIOR was hustled along on the inside to attend the pace, but lacked a response when called upon. WABI SABI broke slowly, came four wide to make a mild rally, but failed to seriously threaten. ROCKUMSOCKUMHARVEY was hustled along in mid pack and went evenly. OUR COOL BOY was bumped at the start to get away slowly, and passed only his tiring rivals. KAPOWSIN CREEK set the pressured pace racing three wide for a half and stopped. MARINE MIKE was hustled along on the inside, was taken up leaving the turn, eased to the wire but walked off.
