SHE'S A SWEETIE lacked early speed, bumped with CRANBERRY GOLD nearing the three-eighths pole, bumped again with that rival while rallying in mid-stretch and was up in the final yards. CRANBERRY GOLD was void of early foot, bumped with the winner nearing the three-eighths marker, bumped again with that foe nearing the eighth pole and finished with good late energy. RUN TIN TIN chased the leaders from the outside and gave way in the drive. SILVER SAVANNAH showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and finished with good late interest. PERFECT FINISH was bumped at the start, rushed to the lead soon after and weakened through the final furlong. DEVILIN was never far back, raced wide through the turn, was bumped nearing the eighth pole while retreating and continued to give way. FANCY PINK GOLD showed brief speed and weakened. The rider of CRANBERRY GOLD lodged an objection against SHE'S A SWEETIE concerning the bumping incident at the three-eighths pole and after reviewing the films the Stewards concluded both horses were at fault and made no change.
